

2019 - 2020 Texas Aggie Graduate Grant Application Instructions

The Texas Aggie Graduate Grant (TAGG) is a need-based award (financial need determined by Scholarships & Financial Aid). Awarding is based on priority deadline and need.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a Texas resident
- Be enrolled in a degree-seeking graduate program (G7 or G8 status) or an eligible graduate certificate program in the Bush School of Government and Public Service
- Be enrolled at least half-time (5 hours for Fall/Spring, 3 hours for Summer)
- Have completed and submitted a FAFSA or TASFA
- Have obtained the signature of your academic department head prior to submitting the application for consideration

Additionally, you will be ineligible to receive funds, or your award will be cancelled, if any one of the following is true:

- You receive tuition payments from any source (university, federal, state, veterans benefits, corporate, or other tuition assistance) during the same semester in which you are awarded TAGG funds
- You receive scholarships or fellowships whose amounts total \$10,000 or more for master's students, \$15,000 or more for doctoral students)
- You are enrolled in professional programs (Colleges of Veterinary Medicine, Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Dentistry, Public Health, and School of Law). These colleges have separate grants you may be eligible to receive.

Student eligibility will be checked at the time of awarding as well as after the census date of each award semester (12th class day for Fall or Spring, and the 5th class day for Summer). **Should a student no longer meet eligibility requirements, all or a portion of the award may be subject to cancellation or adjustment.**

STEPS TO APPLY:

- 1) Fill out the attached form with your full name, UIN, TAMU email address, and all academic periods (including summer) for which you are applying. Please note: if you are awarded funds for fall 2019 and spring 2020, you will not be eligible to receive summer funding.
- 2) Sign and date the form
- 3) Obtain the signature of your academic department head (or their designee)
- 4) Submit your completed and signed application to Scholarships and Financial Aid in person or via fax by the application deadline for full consideration
