## FACTS & FIGURES 2022-2023

Scholarships & Financial Aid administers several large scholarship programs designated for freshman, transfer, and continuing students (both undergraduate and graduate/professional). Scholarships are also available specifically for student veterans, international students, and education abroad. To maintain eligibility for most scholarships, students must be degree seeking and must meet enrollment and scholarship academic progress policy requirements.
