

2022-2023 Texas Aggie Graduate Grant Application Instructions

The Texas Aggie Graduate Grant (TAGG) is a <u>need-based award</u> (financial need determined by Scholarships & Financial Aid). Awarding is based on priority deadline and need.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a Texas resident
- Be enrolled in a degree-seeking graduate program (G7 or G8 classification) or a financial aid eligible graduate certificate program
- Be enrolled at least half-time (5 hours for Fall/Spring, 3 hours for Summer)
- Have completed and submitted a FAFSA or TASFA for the 2022-2023 Academic Year
- Completed and signed application must be submitted for consideration

Note: The following student groups should not complete this application

- Students enrolled in the Health Science Center, Professional and Fort Worth Graduate students in the School of Law, and DVM students in the College of Veterinary Medicine are eligible for funding but not through this application process. Please do not submit an application.
- Students enrolled in Distance Education Graduate programs in the School of Law are not eligible to complete this application. These programs are not supported with state funds and do not qualify for state financial aid (per Texas Education Code Sec. 52.2002/Sec. 54.545).
- Students enrolled in programs offered at the Texas A&M University Washington, D.C., site are not eligible to complete this application.
 These programs are not supported with state funds and do not qualify for state financial aid (per Texas Education Code Sec. 54.2002/Sec. 54.545).

Additionally, you will be ineligible to receive funds, or your award will be canceled, if any one of the following is true:

- *Ineligible* if you receive any tuition payments or other tuition assistance during the same semester in which you are awarded TAGG funds
- *Ineligible* if you receive major scholarships or fellowships (totaling \$10,000 or more for Master's, \$15,000 or more for Doctoral)

Student eligibility will be checked at the time of awarding as well as after the census date of each award semester (12th class day for Fall or Spring, and the 5th class day for Summer). Should a student no longer meet eligibility requirements, all or a portion of the award may be subject to cancellation or adjustment.

STEPS TO APPLY:

- 1) Fill out the attached form with your full name, UIN, TAMU email address, and all academic periods (including summer) for which you are applying. *Please note:* Maximum award per academic year is \$5,000
- 2) Sign and date the form
- 3) Forward the application to your academic department head (or their designee)
- 4) The student must submit the completed, signed application via their Financial Aid Portal

- Not receive any tuition payments or other tuition assistance during the same semester in which you are awarded TAGG funds
- Not receive major scholarships or fellowships (see instructions for amounts)
- Not enrolled in the School of Law or Health Science Center (graduate or professional)
- Not be enrolled in the the DVM professional program in the College of Veterinary Medicine
- Not be enrolled in programs offered at the TAMU Washington D.C. site
