Texas A&M University has proudly served veterans since 1919. There are approximately 1,325 student Veterans on campus. The Aggie One Stop assists eligible students in securing federal and state military education benefits and other education funding including scholarships and financial aid. Scholarships & Financial Aid processes and certifies education benefit eligibility for VA Chapter Benefits and the Hazlewood Act Exemption for both veterans and dependents.

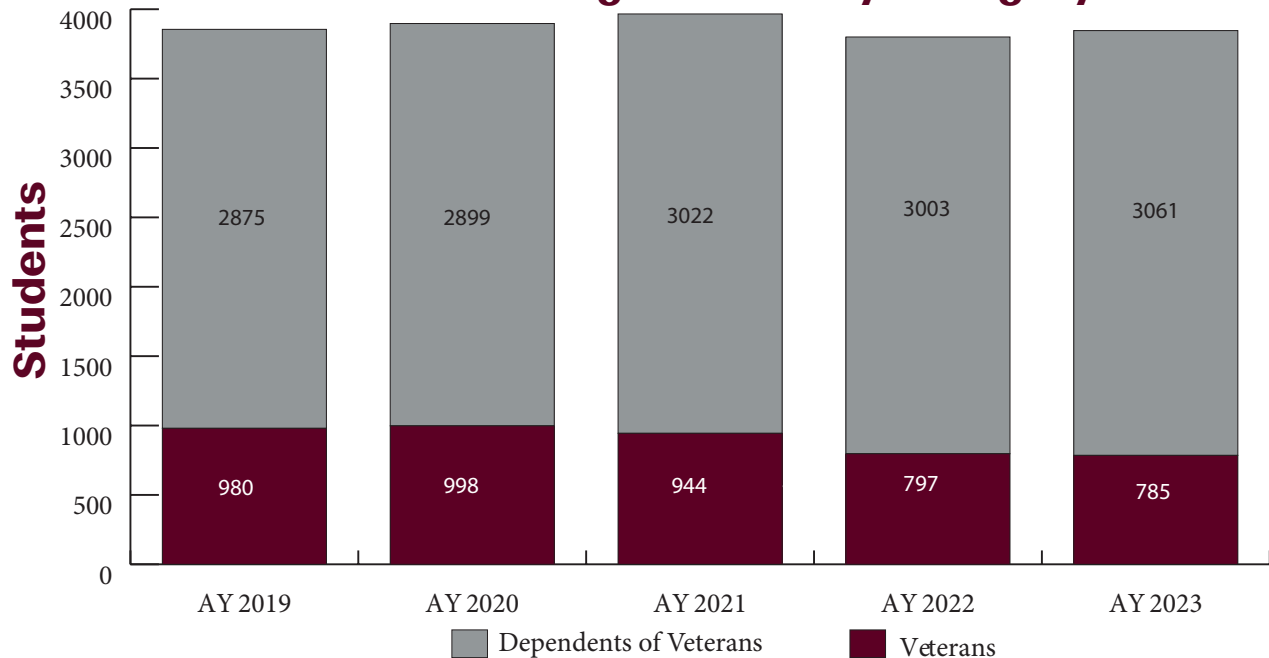
